Black Day to be observed across state on June 26: Comrade Gora

Comrade Daljit Kumar Gora, State Secretary, CITU at the local Gurila Nagar said in a statement that June 26 would be observed as a black day at the joint invitation of Sanyukt Kisan Morcha Delhi and Central Trade Unionists.

He said that on June 26, 1975, the then Prime Minister of India Indira Gandhi had declared a state of emergency in the country and imprisoned Leader of the Opposition and the Left front. But today, Prime Minister Narendra Modi is using similar tactics. Farmers have been sit-

ting on the streets of Delhi for the last seven months and no talks are being held with them to repeal the black law. Comrade Gora said that four codes have been made by violating 44 laws for workers' rights.

Minimum wages are not being increased, contracting system is being introduced in all government agencies, prices of domestic gas, diesel and petrol continue to rise. Workers in cities and villages are struggling with unemployment.
